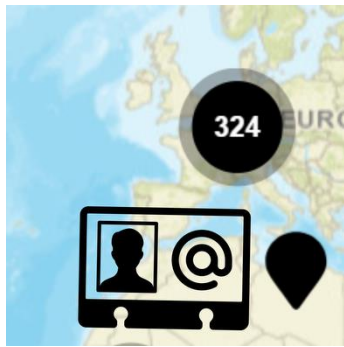

- I understand that they want information about OPDs to put on a map.



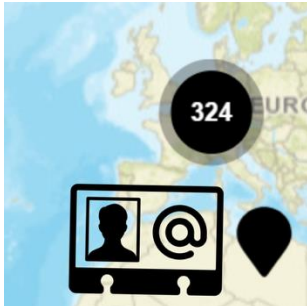
- I have asked all the questions I want.

This means they will keep my private information safe.

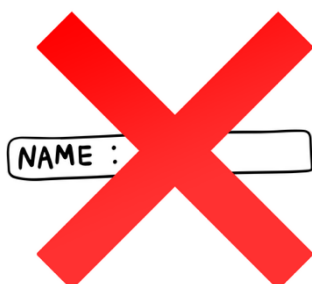


Staff at UCL will check that the research team do a good job.

I am happy for the researchers to use my data in other research.

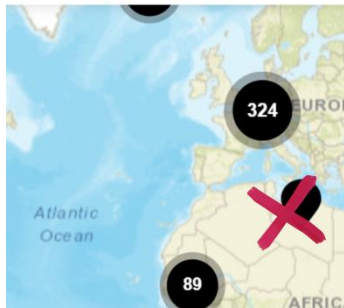
I understand they will never use my name.
